Previously, he taught German, including AP® German in New Mexico for 24 years. He holds a BA in German from the University of Arizona and an MA in German Studies from the University of New Mexico. Mr. Cothrun is past-president of the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages and has served as national president, vice-president and Southwest regional representative for the American Association of Teachers of German.
